- Handle daily Operations of CMO production activities including handling of Change Control, Deviations, and document review
- Ensure efficient and structured meetings and sharing the right information through the whole selection and approval process

You hold a master's degree within natural sciences - Engineering, Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Pharmacy or similar. Together with min. 3 years of experience from a production support role where you have gained some insight into various manufacturing processes, e.g., DS, DP, QA, RA, Filling line, Packaging in a cGMP environment. Understanding of authorities' expectations to DS and DP manufacturing and/or knowledge of CMO environment will be a benefit. Besides very good communication skills in English and some understanding of the Danish language.
